| Requirement Group | | 1 st level in rule hierachy. Gathers a set of requirements for the student. Dark purple line. | EX: University Requirement, Major, Minor (RG 54321) |
| Academic Requirement | | 2nd level in rule hierachy. Does the "work" of the rule. Between purple lines. | (RQ 12345) |
| Requirement Line | | Indicate the number of courses or units required, verified or limited. Yellow triangle only | (LN 010) |
| Course List | | Gather the course(s) needed for the Requirement Line. | Each has a 5 digit course list number, but it will not show on the report. |
